Tent #1 - Twin - Tent Parking is in Front of Tents

- 2 twin beds with clean bedding
- 1 end table
- 1 battery lantern with batteries
- Extra batteries
- 2 sets of bath towels, hand towels, wash clothes
- 1 small rechargeable fan (in summer months)
- Maps
- Extra blankets
- Paper and matches for fire (only when fires are not banned-winter, spring, and late fall)
- Hand Soap
- Cutting Board W/ Knife
- Sea salt & Pepper

- 1 Cast Iron Fry Pan (medium size)
